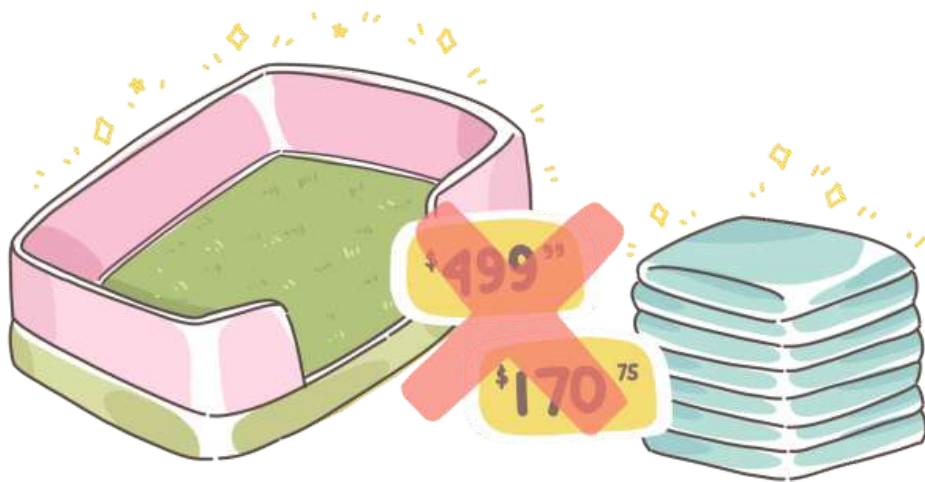

As a result, you have to keep buying these solutions over and over... which adds up to a lot of \$\$\$ over time.

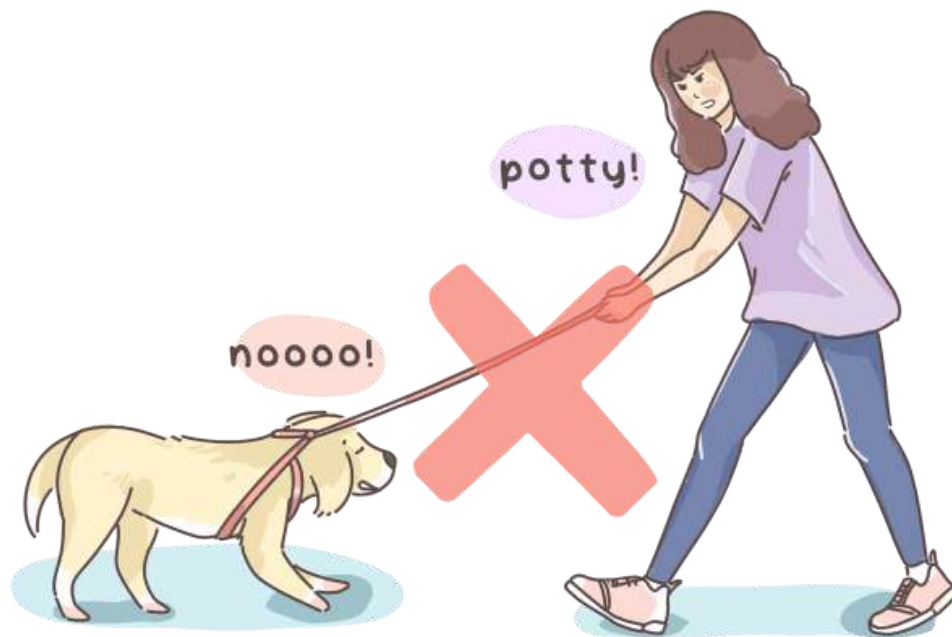
✓ **The solution:**
